RISK ASSESSMENT SHEET

Frequency of use Daily / AS REQUIRED

1. **PEOPLE AT RISK** (instructors, visitors, campers, schools, public)
Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors
2. **HAZARDS** (Anything with the potential to cause harm.)
 - a) Incorrect application/occupation of zorb
 - b) Puncture of zorb
 - c) Incorrect setting up location
 - d) Impact with personal property/ possessions
 - e) Swallowing foodstuff (Choking)
 - f) Uncontrolled Groups/ other site users
 - g) Inclement weather
 - h) Poorly maintained/managed electric cables / fire
 - i) Slipping
3. **ASSESSMENT OF RISK**
 - a) Medium
 - b) Low

4. **LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS**
 - a) **Only** one person to enter and use each zorb ball
 - b) Inspect before each use, area of use to be monitored for damage causing debris.
(Deflation is a slow process)
 - c) Only use on flat ground within the confines of the inflatable track
 - d) Remove all contents of pockets and remove shoes
 - e) No eating or chewing of gum inside the zorb (Safety Briefing)
 - f) Keep all groups away from the zorbs whilst in use by suitable barriers
 - g) Stop using if weather is not suitable i.e. heavy rain or lightning
 - h) Ensure cables are kept away from users and covered where practicable. Generators are turned off when being filled.
 - i) Clear pre activity briefing to be given on correct entering / exiting the zorb and staff to hold in place
